This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of April 14, 2025, through April 20, 2025, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 495 calls for service, 179 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 38 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 2 Car vs. Deer Crash, 3 Hit and Run Crashes, 2 Personal Injury Crashes, 10 Private Property Crashes, 20 Property Damage Crashes, and 1 Vehicle in Ditch.

Retail Fraud 3rd Degree
2139 S Telegraph Rd

On April 15, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report for Retail Fraud 3rd Degree from 2139 S Telegraph Rd, T.J. Maxx. T.J. Maxx's loss prevention detective stated a suspect came into the store and selected a shopping cart. The suspect placed a backpack, four pairs of New Balance sweat pants and a Columbia wind breaker into it. The suspect then proceeded to put all of the items selected into the back pack and walk toward the front of the store. Once the suspect passed all points of sale the loss prevention detective confronted him and the suspect handed over the bag and ran out of the store. The suspect is described as a black male approximately 6'0" tall and 180 lbs. wearing a black jacket, grey sweatpants, red shoes and a mask. He was last seen leaving the area on a red minibike. The merchandise taken totaled \$149.97. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Investigations unit and is currently under investigation. Bingham Road / Lincoln Road
Possession of Methamphetamine
ARREST MADE

On April 19, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department responded to the area of Bingham Road/Lincoln Road for a motorist that was asleep at the wheel of a small blue car. When officers arrived in the area they discovered Christopher Mahlebashian asleep inside of the vehicle. While officers were conducting their investigation, it was discovered that Mahlebashian was in possession of 0.6 grams of Methamphetamine and was subsequently arrested.

On April 20, 2025, The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office signed a one-count warrant for possession of methamphetamine. Mahlebashian was arraigned in front of Judge Ellwanger and received a \$10,000.00, 10% bond.
