This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. Summary:

During the timeframe of January 13, 2025, through January 19, 2025, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 396 calls for service, 68 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 41 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 23 Property Damage Crashes, 6 Personal Injury Crashes, 5 Hit and Run Crashes, 6 Private Property Crashes, and 1 Car vs. Deer Crash.
