This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of July 7, 2026, through July 12, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 436 calls for service, 178 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 24 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 13 Property Damage Crashes, 5 Personal Injury Crashes, 3 Hit and Run Crashes, 2 Private Property Crashes, 1 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes.

3675 W. Maple Road (Plum Market)

On July 10, 2026, at approximately 6:00 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Plum Market, located at 3675 W. Maple Road, for a Retail Fraud that had just occurred. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspect, who was standing at the customer service desk. Officers spoke with a 23-year-old female, who admitted to stealing a few items by putting them in her purse. The items stolen included coffee, sour cream, and juice, with a total value of \$34.47. Officers issued the suspect a misdemeanor citation for Retail Fraud, and she was released from the scene.

On July 10, 2026, at approximately 6:00 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Target, located at 2400 S. Telegraph Road, for a Retail Fraud that had just occurred. Officers were advised that the suspect had just left southbound on Telegraph Road in a black Kia. The suspect was described as a black female wearing all black with white glasses and a brightly colored purse.

Officers located the Kia and the suspect, who matched the provided description, on Telegraph Road near Maple Road. Officers conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and spoke with the suspect, a 36-year-old female. The stolen items were recovered from inside the vehicle which included a tank top, a pink glass bowl, and a silver chain, with a total value of \$37.00. Officers issued the suspect a misdemeanor citation for Retail Fraud, and she was released from the scene
