This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of March 23, 2026, through March 29, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 503 calls for service, 174 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 32 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 1 Car vs. Deer Crash, 6 Hit and Run Crashes, 0 Non-UD-10 Crashes, 2 Personal Injury Crashes, 2 Private Property Crashes and 21 Property Damage Crashes.

**Retail Fraud Misrepresentation 3rd Degree
2400 S Telegraph Road (Target)
Arrest Made**

On March 29, 2026, at approximately 4:00 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to Target, located at 2400 S Telegraph Road for a Retail Fraud in Progress (price tag switching). Officers were told the suspect was a black female dressed in a black shirt, white pants, holding a Gucci bag and a large plastic bag. She was trying to leave the location in a white Mercedes Benz. Officers located her in the parking garage. The suspect had switched the price tag on OxiClean dishwasher tabs, Cottonelle toilet paper, a bed comforter set and two shower mats totaling approximately \$150. The suspect, a 36-year-old black female from Bloomfield Hills, was subsequently arrested for Retail Fraud Misrepresentation 3rd Degree. She was issued a citation and released from the scene pending a court date.

**Retail Fraud 2nd Degree
2139 S Telegraph Road (TJ Maxx)
Arrest Made**

On March 26, 2026, at approximately 5:00 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department was dispatched to TJ Maxx located at 2139 S Telegraph Road for a Retail Fraud. Officers arrived and located the suspect who was detained by TJ Maxx Loss Prevention. The suspect, identified as Jeremy Barber, 34- year-old black male from Detroit had been stopped by Loss Prevention officers as he attempted to leave the store without paying for two JBL Headphones totaling approximately \$50.00. Jeremy Barber had a prior conviction for Retail Fraud and was subsequently arrested for Retail Fraud 2nd Degree. Barber transported back to the Bloomfield township Police Department where he was processed. On March 27, 2026 the Oakland County Prosecutors Office approved a one count Retail Fraud 2nd warrant. Barber was arraigned in front of Magistrate Nelson-Klein who issued a \$50,000 cash bond.
